Submission Guidelines:

Undergraduate students from PASSHE institutions are eligible to submit 1-3 poems to Dr. Brent House at eapsu@calu.edu by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 1, 2017. In the subject line of the e-mail, type "EAPSU Poetry Contest."

Submissions should be attached as a .doc or .docx file. Please do not include the poet's name on the manuscript. Center the title of each poem, begin each poem on a separate page, and use a standard font.

In the message of the e-mail, please include complete contact information for the submitter: name, institutional affiliation, university address, phone number and e-mail address. Also please include the title(s) of the poem(s).

Prizes:

Winning poets receive \$100 (first prize); \$50 (second prize), and \$25 (third prize), and they will be invited to read their work at the 2017 EAPSU Undergraduate Conference.
